HLTAID011 Provide First Aid BLENDED LEARNING COURSE

Description

This unit of competency develops the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response, life support, management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance. This course is aimed at clients wishing work in any industry or the general community who wish to gain first aid skills for their workplace or personal benefit. This course is of particular interest to those people working in childcare, primary or secondary schools, aged care and industrial workplaces.

Duration

This course is delivered through blended learning comprising a self-paced theory session and a face-to-face practical session. The self-paced theory session can be completed at the student's home or workplace and the duration can vary according to the student's existing knowledge and the pace that they work at. The session comprises reading a learner guide and answering a series of theory questions. At the completion of the session students must submit completed theory assessment to the RTO and a practical session will then be scheduled. The practical session runs for approximately 5 hours and will be held either at Narre Warren Community Learning Centre or in the workplace. The total number of maximum hours for this course is 10 hours. The assessments are conducted during the practical session.

For those students completing this course as a refresher it is likely that the theory session would take 1 – 2 hours and the practical session would be held for 4 hours. Therefore, as a refresher, a total of 6 hours at a maximum would be required.

Resources

Students will need access to a computer, internet, e-mail and a printer in order to complete the self-paced on-line session.

Delivery Modes

Self-paced (home/workplace) and Face to Face (training room/workplace)

Entry Requirements and Pre-requisites

While there are no specific entry requirements for this course, clients should possess basic language, literacy and numeracy skills. This course is not suitable for students with language, literacy and/or numeracy difficulties. These students should book into the 2 day face-to-face course.
